Thomas Jefferson's Image of New England Jul 07 2020 Writers often depict Thomas Jefferson as a narrow-minded defender of states' rights and Virginia's interests, despite his authorship of the Declaration of Independence and vigorous defense of the young republic's sovereignty. Some historians claim he was particularly hostile to the New England states, whose Federalist

electorate he regarded as enemies of his Democratic-Republican Party.
