**meeting the needs of gifted and talented students** Mar 31 2020 students who are gifted and talented may also have a disability and or english as an additional language or dialect research suggests that 14 per cent of children who are identified as being intellectually gifted may also have a learning disability whereas only about 4 per cent of children in the general population may also have a learning disability
